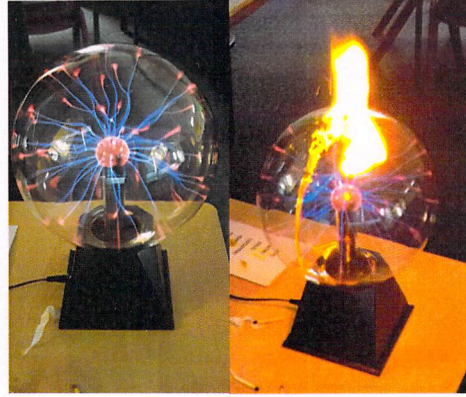
## Science Week
