Attendance is essential for your child's academic progress and social interactions.

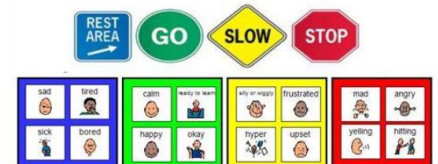


We have an expectation that every pupil should aim for 100% attendance. By making regular school attendance a priority, you can help set your child on the path to success. Our attendance year to date is 95% and our target is 97%. Please ensure your child arrives on time each day as every minute late is a minute lost learning.

Zones of Regulation

In assembly we introduced 'Zones of Regulation' which is a system that categorises states of alertness and emotions into four coloured zones designed to foster self-regulation and emotional control. The zones help pupils visually and verbally self-identify how they are functioning in the moment, by understanding the emotions they feel and states of alertness. Teachers can then support children to move between the zones.
