Morning Drop Off

The children are doing incredibly well now with entering the setting confidently in the morning. Routines are becoming embedded and they know exactly what to do once they enter the classroom. Can I take this opportunity to ask that PE kits come into school on Tuesday and go home with the children in the afternoon, just to give them a bit more space on their pegs.
