- Art- Produce a piece of work in the style of Giuseppe Arcimboldo
- DT- Create your own weather instrument for your garden
- Geography- Draw a map of your route to school
- History- Find out a fact about the local area from before you were born
- MFL- Create a poster displaying the numbers from 1-10
- Music- Perform a song/nursery rhyme that mentions rain
- PE- Travel to school using 3 different forms of transport (Walking, scooter, bike,etc)
