Project Idea

Our Geography focus this half-term is Rivers. We will be studying Van Gogh in our art work.

You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started. Can you link your homework to another area of the curriculum?

- Maths- Draw a graph to show the length of different rivers around the world
- English- Create a leaflet about the rivers of Britain
- Science- List the different states of matter you see throughout a day
- Art- Produce a piece of work in the style of Van Gogh
- DT- Design and make a pop-up book about your favourite character
- Geography- Find out about protecting the rivers around the world
- History- Present some information about Van Gogh
- MFL- Which rivers flow through France? Write a paragraph in French about them
- Music- Write a song about rivers
- PE- Put together a routine of shapes using your body
- Computing- Design a presentation about one of the topics

Remember, you can choose what you want to do for your project and you aren't limited to just one idea. I'm looking forward to seeing your ideas and what you come up with!
