Project Idea

Our Geography focus this half-term is North America. We will be studying Barbara Hepworth in our art work, and our science topic is “Living Things in their Habitats.”

You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started. Can you link your homework to another area of the curriculum?

- **Maths**- Find the area of some of the different countries in North America
- **English**- Write a letter to someone about your life in the UK compared to their country
- **Science**- Create a “choice chamber” to find the ideal habitat for a garden insect
- **Art**- Produce a piece of work in the style of Barbara Hepworth
- **DT**- Design and build a Native American totem pole
- **Geography**- Find out about the rivers or mountains in North America and order them according to size
- **History**- Create a presentation about the Native Americans
- **MFL**- Which countries in the North America speak French? Write a paragraph in French about them
- **Music**- Learn a national anthem from one of the countries
- **PE**- Create a video demonstrating a North American sport
- **Computing**- Create an iMovie/video about a North American meal and how to make it

Remember, you can choose what you want to do for your project and you aren't limited to just one idea. I'm looking forward to seeing your ideas and what you come up with!
