Class Information for children:

Reading: You will take home an accelerated reading book based on your reading age. Please complete the weekly reading log in your planner and we encourage you to read at least **three** times each week – please could you ask your grown up to sign your planner to let us know you have done this. It is essential that your planner is in school every day as it is a very useful resource.

Spellings: You will be taught spellings each week and these will be stuck into your planner so you can practise and show your grown up. There won't be a weekly spelling test.

Homework : There will be a weekly homework activity each Friday to be completed. This will either consolidate work being covered in class or involve practising a key skill. Homework will be shared in the children's planners at the end of each week. I will use Google classroom to send out reminders and links to anything you might need. I will also add a link which takes you to the Outwood Primary Learning Library Website. Here you will find the knowledge organiser / quiz for the topics you will be learning so you can take a look at home and share it with your grown up. Extra information for parents / carers:

PE : Your child's PE lessons will take place on **Monday and Thursday**. However, it is best to have their PE kits in school all week; your child should bring them in on Monday and take

them home on Friday. PE kit consists of: black shorts, black PE socks and **purple / white** t-shirt. Trainers/pumps and a plain warm top are required for outdoor PE.

Inhalers: If your child requires an inhaler please ensure that this is still in date and handed in to the school office. Please let school know if there is any other medical information that you would like us to know about.

Glasses: If your child wears glasses, please encourage them to bring them each day and we will encourage them to take them home at the end of the day.

Water Bottles: Please provide your child with a water bottle to ensure they stay hydrated throughout the day.

Snacks: We are more than happy for your child to bring a snack for break times but please ensure this is a healthy one eg fruit / healthy snack bar. These must be placed in your child's bag / book bag and **not** in their lunch box as there is no access to the lunch box trolley until lunchtime.

Planners: when the children receive their planner please sign the relevant pages (pages 6, 10 & 11) and encourage your child to bring it into school each day as it will be used in lessons on a daily basis.

We will be holding a short welcome meeting for parents on Monday 25th September at 3.15pm in the Y6 classroom. This is an opportunity for us to share what we will be covering in Y6, talk through the year 6 SATs and answer any questions you may have. Your children will be able to wait in the ICT suite during this time.
