

ADMISSION TO OUTWOOD GRANGE ACADEMY – SEPTEMBER 2022

Dear Parent/Carer

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to Outwood Grange Academy and I am delighted that your child is to join the Academy in September 2022. I hope that the time they will spend here will be both happy and memorable. It is our ambition that every student leaves here a confident, successful and responsible young adult.

We will shortly be starting the process of transition with visits to our Academy site, these will commence the week beginning 4th July. It is our intention that your child have two visits to the Academy, so that they can familiarise themselves with the school. We will also be holding a Parents Information Evening on 12th July, this will enable all parents to visit the site and ask any questions you may have.

We also regularly meet with Primary School Head Teachers and will ensure that we work closely with them to avail ourselves of all the teacher assessment, test information and any other relevant details regarding how we can best support transition to the Academy. As I am sure you are aware, the Academy is a member of the Outwood Grange Academies Trust and we are excited to be part of such a successful Trust and the impact the support will have on all of our students.

Over the next few months there will be a number of transition resources and information provided by the Academy. Firstly, we will be sending a link to a google form for you to complete, this will contain information regarding key data required for admissions to OGA. In order to access this we need to collect an email address from you to send the form. Please can you complete the transition details form with all the personal details for your child. This must be completed by Sunday 22nd May, follow this link to complete an online version of the form which can also be found on our website. [Transition Collection Form](#). You will need this unique passcode to complete this form, this can be obtained from your Y6 Transition contact at your primary school. If you have any questions please contact us via the transition email address below.

We know both students, parents and carers will have many questions to ask and have included lots of helpful resources on our transition website, to allow you to see what life at the Academy will be like and to help allay any fears or worries. It is crucial we get all of the details from you, so we can keep you in the loop with any key information and initiatives.
