Project Idea

Our History focus this half-term is **Anglo-Saxons and Vikings** and we will be studying **figureheads** in art. You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started.

Maths- Create 2D or 3D figurehead using a range of shapes.

English- Write a diary entry from the perspective of a Viking child.

Science - Draw a diagram of the anatomy of a human and label key parts.

Art- Create your own Viking ship complete with a ferocious figurehead.

DT- Make a Viking ship using lollipop sticks.

Geography - Draw a map to show where the Vikings came from and where in Britain they landed.

History - Research an aspect of the lives of the Anglo-Saxons or Vikings.

MFL- Write a song in French all about Summer!

Music- If you play an instrument, create a piece of music inspired by the Vikings.

PE- Create a raiders and invaders game based on the Vikings.

Computing- Create a digital poster all about reading power!
