- Geography- Draw a map of the UK and its seaside towns
- History- Make a poster on how the seaside used to be different in the olden French Numbers 1-20
- *MFL* Create a poster displaying the numbers from 1-20
- Music- Perform a song of the numbers to 20 in French
- PE- Creature your own dance using the movements of different animals
