## Project Idea

This term our topic is all about **Rivers** and will link to Geography, Science and DT. I would like you to complete a project based on the topics we have been exploring in school. We will share your homework projects with the rest of the class, and have an opportunity to discuss what others have learnt about the topic.

Below are a few suggestions – but please feel free to try something of your own!

- Produce a fact file about world rivers. Include as many interesting facts as you can.
- Melt chocolate (yummy!) Explain what happened to the chocolate using scientific language. Perhaps you could even freeze it again and describe this also.
- Make a model of a boat this might be a sailing boat, dinghy, barge, canoe, or any other boat you might find on a river.
- Use your poetry skills to write a poem about rivers.
- Draw or paint a picture in the style of Vincent Van Gogh.
- Make a rain gauge and keep a record of how much rain falls. Make a graph or table to show your results.
- Create a sculpture of a river creature or plant. You could use clay, salt dough, papier mache or any material of your choice.
- Build a 3D model or create a board game about the course of a river.
