Project Idea

At the end of the term, we will have a homework presentation afternoon. This term our topic is all about Ancient Greece and links to History and Art. On our presentation afternoon, you will share your homework projects with the rest of the class, and have an opportunity to discuss what others have learnt about the topic.

Below are a few suggestions – but please feel free to try something of your own!

- o Produce a fact file about one of Ancient Greece's key people! (For example: Alexander the Great, Zeus or Archimedes) Include as many interesting facts as you can.
- Design your own mythical beast and label their features.
- Create a code to crack using the Greek Alphabet.
- Make a set of Top Trump cards about the Greek Gods.
- Create a piece of Greek artwork such as a mosaic.
- Produce a bar chart or line graph to show temperatures or rainfall in Greece.
- Write a newspaper article about the battle of Troy.
- Cook a traditional Greek recipe.
- Hold your own mini-Olympic games with your family. Take photos to show the events and draw a results table to show who won.
- o Sketch the horse from the story of Troy. Try to use a range of shading skills (stippling, hatching, cross-hatching etc.)
- Made a model of the Trojan horse.
- o Create your own musical instrument (science). Can you explain how the sound is made?
