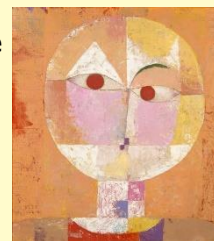

Project Idea

Our focus this half-term is Animals! We will be learning about living things in their habitats and the work of Paul Klee in Art. We will be writing newspaper reports and letters in English and we will also be learning about bridges in DT!

You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started. Can you link your homework to another area of the curriculum?

- **Maths**- Create a portrait in the style of Paul Klee made specifically from shapes
- **English**- Write your own newspaper report about animals and their habitats
- **Science**- Make a 3D microhabitat at home and document which animals you get
- **Art**- Produce a portrait in the style of Paul Klee using printing
- **DT**- Create your own 3D bridge
- **Geography**- Create a map of animals in the world and where they live
- **History**- Make a fact file about extinct animals from the past
- **MFL**- Create a poster about the different animals in French
- **Music**- Perform a song or compose your own
- **PE**- Create your own gymnastic routine using apparatus
