This half-term we will be looking at human growth and development in science, how computers impact our lives in Computing, sustainable development in Geography and Leonardo Da Vinci in Art.You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started. Can you link your homework to another area of the curriculum?

- Maths- Research the links between Leonardo Da Vinci's artwork and mathematics.
- English- Write a balanced argument about the use of renewable energy sources.
- Science- Research the gestation periods of your favourite animals and produce a poster comparing them.
- Art- Create a piece of art inspired by the work of Leonardo Da Vinci.
- DT- Design your own invention that could help with a more sustainable future.
- Geography- Research the global goals and create a proposal for how we could help achieve them in school.
- *History* Create a poster of the timeline of the modern computer.
- MFL- Record a video yourself having a conversation in French.
- RE- Create slides comparing the 5 main religions.
- *Music* Write your own upbeat, happy song.
- Computing- Create a website about the ways you could reduce the negative impacts of computers on your life.

Remember, you can choose what you want to do for your project and you aren't limited to just one idea. I'm looking forward to seeing your ideas and what you come up with!
