- Art- Produce a picture of different mining tools using s using charcoal
- DT- Create your own moving car using a balloon
- Geography- Create a map of the mines in our local area
- History- Make a fact file about mining
- MFL- Create a poster about yourself in French
- Music- Perform a song or compose your own
- PE- Creature your own gymnastic routine using apparatus
