Dear Parent/carer,

We are excited to inform you that our school has organised a trip to Abbey House Museum in Leeds on Tuesday 6th June 2023 for our Year 1 children. This is a unique Victorian museum that offers a fascinating insight into life during the 19th century. The museum has an authentic Victorian street, where children can explore and experience what it was like to live in the past.

The full cost of the trip is £470 (coach £350 + entry fees and workshop £120).

School is subsidising some of the cost but in order for the trip to go ahead we are asking for voluntary contributions of £13 per child. This is payable on ParentPay please by Friday 20th May. It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions, it will not be possible for the trip to take place.

During the visit, the children will participate in a 'History through Toys' workshop where they will learn about the toys children played with during the Victorian era which also links to our previous History unit of Toys in Autumn 2.

Additionally, if the weather is permitting, we plan to have a picnic outside Kirkstall Abbey. The children will be provided with a packed lunch under universal free school meals where a selection of sandwiches will be available. A separate letter will be sent home with regards to this.

Please can you ensure the children are wearing school uniform, a warm coat and sensible shoes. We will be leaving school at 9:15am and return before the end of the school day.

We want to assure you that the safety and well-being of the children are our top priority. We will ensure that all necessary precautions are taken to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip for all.
